

Family Tree of the Royal Houses, Irving of Bonshaw and Irvine of Drum

Preface:

The 16 sheets of this family tree extend to a total length of 44 feet. The sheets were first compiled between 1958 and 1970, and most were amended to 1970 (sheet I to 1986). One copy of each sheet had the shields coloured, but a complete series of these no longer survives. The copies on this CD are in black and white, thus:

A few of the surviving sheets are damp-stained. For on-screen viewing all sheets have to be zoomed in "View". EJB Irving wrote the following Legend to accompany his tree:

The 16 Sheets forming this Family Tree, when joined together, also join together all persons shown, except IRVINGS of SWEDEN on Sheet K.

Those of the same Generation are on the same Horizontal Line, except Sheet AA. Where no surname appears, then that person is IRVING (any spelling) or a female.

The Horizontal connecting lines between Sheets are omitted in some cases (to give more space for Arms), but this is made clear by arrows on the Right Hand edges which indicate the source & finish of the missing line, e.g. on Sheet D1, 5A → 5G, means that the line joining Generation 5 on Sheet A to Generation 5 on Sheet G, is omitted.

For convenience, CHRISTOPHER IRVING of BONSHAW c1450-1513 is numbered Generation 1, leading down to generation 17 or 18 for the Present Day and numbered backwards from 1, as 01, 02, 03, &c, for more remote Generations. The Generation Nos. are shown on the Left Hand edge of each Sheet.

Sheet A is the Pedigree of Royal Families and shows the connexion between the IRVING FAMILY and the SCOTTISH ROYAL LINE; also where DRUM sprang from BONSHAW.

Sheets A to H1 show IRVINGS of BONSHAW.

Sheets I to K show IRVINES of DRUM.

This Tree has been compiled over many years and an attempt has been made to be consistent. However, as time went on, improvements were adopted which do not all appear in the earlier entries.

Triple lines lead to IRVINGS "of BONSHAW" or to IRVINES "of DRUM".

Double lines lead to IRVING/IRVINE MALES.

Single lines lead to all others.

Generally the Surname of a husband marrying into the Family is shown in CAPITALS.

Generally Titles, Ranks, Professions, &c. are shown in Italics.

ARMS: IRVING/IRVINE Shields are shown with Crests & Mottoes when known.
 All known IRVING/IRVINE Arms are shown but not all are connected to persons on the Tree and such Arms are not numbered.
 Shields only are shown for other Families; with some exceptions.
